CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

- 1. There is no selection of works. Artists (over 18 years) will participate upon payment of the subscription.**
2. Works will not be for sale and are not under insurance. They will be included in the MINIARTE INTERNATIONAL PROJECT – Collection VIDA, and if this collection is shown again, the artist will not be charged.
3. Works that do not follow these rules will not be accepted.



PARTICIPATION FEE

- USD\$25,00 (twenty-five American dollars) per artist.
- Period of subscription – From April, 5 to June 20, 2021.
- **DEADLINE FOR SUBSCRIPTIONS AND PHOTOS - June 20, 2021.**



PARTICIPATION FEE – SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. For groups of 10 (ten) artists – participation fee is USD20,00 (twenty American dollars) per artist.
2. The leader of the group (11th subscription) will be free of subscription

RULES

Article 1 – The 40th & 41st edition of the Miniarte International Project VIDA (Collection VIDA) will be hybrid (presential and virtual). Each participant will only send a **photo of her/his work under the theme VIDA (Life), in SQUARE FORMAT**, using any technique.

Article 2 – The artist will send only the **photo of the work, informing name, technique and country of residence**. It is not necessary to entitle the work, and the original may be on 2 or 3 dimensions. Photos will be printed in 18x18cm, in fine art canvas, and mounted under the system already used in former Miniartes.

Article 3 – **Do not send photos through whatsapp**. Send a digital photo to clarapech@gmail.com within the deadline above (June 25, 2021). Photo must be **square**, in high resolution, JPG in 300dpi, Minimum 1 Mega, Maximum 2 Mega.

In the item “Subject” write the name of the artist. Use the same name that you want to appear in the catalogue. **Follow the arrival of your photo for MINIARTE VIDA by Flickr:** <http://www.flickr.com/photos/miniart2010/sets/>

Article 4 – **Catalogue** - The good quality of the photo will generate a better quality in the catalogue, that will be only **virtual and will be published in the website** <https://www.miniartex.org>.



Article 5 – **Artist's compromise** - Paying the fee implies on artist's commitment to send payment and photo until deadline, besides following the articles of these rules. The artist is also authorising the organization of the event to publicize his/her work in Brazil and abroad.

Article 6 – **General International Coordination** - All above items are mandatory. Messages with questions or doubts must be sent only to clarapech@gmail.com. Cases not mentioned in these rules will be solved by the Coordinator in collaboration with the Miniart partners.
